

## Chief Warden

This course is designed to provide you with the skills, knowledge, and experience to perform the duties of a Chief Warden in your workplace.


This course meets the requirements of *Australian Standard AS3745 Planning for emergencies in facilities*.

### Duration and Location

This course is delivered in over (1) hour. Chief Warden can be delivered at your premises (if suitable), or at a Chubb training facility.

If required, this course can be combined with a workplace evacuation exercise, or fire extinguisher training.

### Content

- Standards and legislation
  - The emergency plan and procedures
  - Types of workplace emergencies
  - Human behaviour during emergencies
  - The structure and roles of the Emergency Control Organisation
  - Preparing for and preventing emergencies
  - Responding to emergencies
  - Decision-making, command and control
  - Coordination and communication

- Workplace emergency systems
  - Operating emergency warning and communications systems
  - Liaison with Emergency Services

### Course Participation

This course is limited to a maximum of 15 participants.

To get the most out of this course, participants should be familiar with the emergency plan and procedures for their workplace. Participants are encouraged to bring a copy of their workplace emergency plan and their Chief Warden identification (white cap, helmet or vest) if possible.
