Cookie Policy

Cookie Notice

This "Cookie Notice" (the "Notice") explains how and why Chubb Group companies (also referred to as "Chubb", "we", "our" and "us") will use different types of cookies and similar technologies on any websites or apps (the "Site") that we own or control. This Notice also explains how you can manage cookies and similar technologies.

We keep this Notice under regular review and may update it at any time. Please take a look at the "Last Updated" section at the top of this Notice to see when it was last changes. Any changes in this Notice will become effective which we make the revised Notice available on or through the Site. We also encourage you to check this Notice on a regular basis. We will notify you of any changes (including when they will take effect) if we are required to do so by data protection or e-privacy laws.

What are Cookies?

When you visit our website, one or more "cookies" are generated and deployed with your consent, if required.

Cookies are small files of letters and numbers that are stored on your browser and/or the hard dive of your computer (or other internet-enabled devices, such as a smartphone or tablet) when you visit the Site. A cookie will usually contain the name of the website from which the cookie has come from, the "lifetime" of the cookie (i.e. how long it will remain on your device) and a value, which is usually a randomly generated unique number.

We use cookies to make the Site easier to use and to better tailor our web presence and products to your interests and needs. Cookies are also used to help speed up your future activities and deliver a more personalised experience on the Site.

Some cookies may process your personal data (e.g. IP addresses and other online identifiers). Please see Chubb's Privacy Notice for further details about how your personal data is processed and your rights in relation to this.

Other cookies are used to compile anonymous, aggregated statistics that allow us to understand how people use our web properties and to help us improve web structure and

content. We cannot identify you personally from this information although the same principles apply regarding these cookies.

Categories of Cookies Used on The Site:

Two types of cookies will be used on the Site, "session cookies" and "persistent cookies". Session cookies are temporary cookies that remain on your device until you leave this Site. A persistent cookie remains on your device for much longer or until you manually delete it (how long the cookie remains on your device will depend on the duration or "lifetime" of the specific cookie and your browser settings).

We have grouped our cookies into the following categories, to make it easier for you to understand why we use them:

- Essential/Necessary: Cookies that are essential to making the Site work correctly. They enable visitors to move around our Site and use our features. These cookies prevent crashes, display information, fix bugs and ensure the security of our website. Without these cookies, some functions of the website cannot be provided. These cookies do not identify you as an individual.
- <u>Functional:</u> Cookies that allow our web properties to recognise you when you return
 to the Site and 'remember' the choices you make (such as your user name, language
 or the region you are in) to provide a more personalised online experience. If you do
 not accept these cookies, it may affect Site performance and functionality and may
 restrict access to web content.
- Performance/Analytical: Cookies that help us understand how visitors interact with our web properties by providing information about the areas visited, the time spent on the Site and any issues encountered, such as error messages. They help us improve the performance of our Site, alert us to any concerns and more. They tell us how popular a certain feature is, or whether you open an email we send. These cookies don't identify you as an individual, unless stated otherwise.
- Advertisement: Cookies that are used to provide visitors with relevant ads and marketing campaigns. These cookies track visitors across websites and collect information to provide customized advertisements.

Cookies on this Site

The table below summarises the different types of cookies we use on the Site, together with their respective purpose and whether their use involves the transfer of information to a third party:

Necessary cookies are absolutely essential for the website to function properly. These cookies ensure basic functionalities and security features of the website, anonymously. Types of necessary cookie used by this website and its cookie plugin are as shown in the below table.

viewed_cookie_policy	11 months	The cookie is set by the GDPR Cookie Consent plugin and is used to store whether or not user has consented to the use of cookies. It does not store any personal data. Needed for plugin and website.

- measure and analyse the performance of our advertising campaigns;

Managing Cookies on Your Device

When you access Chubb websites for the first time, you will be prompted to make decisions on your cookie preferences through the cookie plugin that will appear on your screen. Whilst necessary cookies will always be enabled, you can make your own choices regarding other types of cookies. After your first visit, you may occasionally be asked to reconfirm your cookie preferences on future visits to the websites.

You can also manage which optional cookies are deployed on your device at any time. To do this you can set browser settings accordingly. Guidance on how to control cookies for common browsers can be found online.
